Update – North East Local Restrictions [18.9.20]

Routines and behaviour

We have had another great week in terms of learning, play and behaviour. Playtimes are calm and every group, in their zone, is playing enthusiastically together. We continue to promote ‘safe distances’ in school – where we can in class, when lining up and when moving around the school.

Information from Friday 18th

You will be aware that new guidance on local restrictions for the North East have been announced, with immediate effect.

To repeat our last week’s update, **our staggered starts work well**, and very few parents are at the gate at the same time. **Our home-times are not great**, and we need your help while our pick up times are much closer together.

- **Please maintain a social distance of 2m on site and outside of the gates.**
- **Please do not mix with others out of your own household.**
- **Once you have collected your child(ren), please leave the school site/drive area straight away.**

If we are concerned about social distancing during pick up times, we will have to review the system of pick up – potentially ending the school day earlier, to get all children home more safely through a less crowded area.

Please help us keep the children, yourselves and the staff safe and well, and help us to keep our school working as it is, and open!
