

# Hesleden Primary School



Dear Parents/Carers,

This year, due to Covid-19 restrictions, we have not been able to take part in educational visits, however, now that restrictions are easing we are providing all children in school an outing free of charge.

**The children from Class 1 (Nursery and Reception) will be visiting Tweddle Farm on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> May. The visit will take place in school time, leaving shortly after 9am, and returning at approximately 2.30pm.**

Any Nursery children who usually only attend for a half-day will attend for the full day.

All activity and Covid-safe risk assessments have been provided to us and prepared for the visit. As you would expect, all staff working with the children will be cleared to work with them, and school based staff will accompany each small group of children.

## **What the children will need:**

- Sun cream should be applied at home before arrival at school if the weather is warm
- Children should wear:
  - Uniform tops where possible
  - Bottoms should be suitable for the day (i.e. tracksuit bottoms)
  - Suitable footwear for a farm visit (i.e. trainers)
- Children should bring a **small rucksack** to contain:
  - Waterproof coat (children should wear this if it is raining)
  - Sun hat (if the weather is warm)
  - Full water bottle
  - Packed lunch (*If your child normally has school meals they will be provided with a school packed lunch otherwise one should be brought from home in a backpack*)
