### Summer term - arrangements for the final weeks

Please find below some low-key events which have been planned for the children, and other information you need to know about the end of term.

### Parent consultations / End of term reports

- **Parent Consultations** for children in Reception to Year 6 will be by telephone and will take place during w/c 5<sup>th</sup> July (next week). Each phone call will last no more than 5 minutes and teachers will give you a brief overview of how your child has settled and what progress has been made during the term.
- **Reports** will be sent home once all phone calls have been made (hopefully by Friday 9<sup>th</sup>, or Monday 12<sup>th</sup> at the latest). Reports will contain further brief comments and an overview of teacher assessed data. When you receive your child's report, you will also receive information about class organisation for next year. This will not be discussed in phone calls.

### Sports

- We are planning to hold class-bubble sports carousels next week, although the weather forecast is not looking good! Children will take part in activities within their class across the day. (Class 4 will have their day in the following week)
- Children in Classes 2, 3 and 5 should wear their PE kit on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> July **and** Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> July for their normal PE day.
- Children in Class 1 & Childcare should wear their PE kit as normal on the Thursday

### 'Proud of me' day

- Instead of our usual Awards event, we are holding a 'proud of me' day on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> July. Across the day we will be celebrating the children's achievements and progress from this year.
- Adam Bushnell will be in school to celebrate with each class and he will present awards to the children during his session with them.
- This will be a non-uniform day. Children can come to school dressed in an outfit which represents who they are and to show off what makes them proud. This might be from a uniformed organisation (cubs/brownies etc.) or a kit from a team they represent. Children can also come to school in their normal uniform if they would prefer.

### Last day of term

- This year we will not be holding our usual children's festival so we have booked an inflatable slide for the last day and will timetable each class throughout the morning.
- We will be having lunch together on the field, picnic-style, like last year, to be finished off with a treat.
- School will close to children from lunchtime on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> July, in order for us to say goodbye in a socially distanced way. Collection will take place, from the yard, at the following times:
